Maryville Razzle Dazzle Runs Marian to Frazzle

Razzle-dazzle play by Maryville academy's backfield and 107 yards in penalties were too much for Marian to overcome Saturday as it dropped its season opener, 26 to 6 at Des Plaines.

The Spartans held a 6 to 0 lead after the first period, but fell behind 13 to 6 at the half. Two fourth quarter scores clinched the decision for Maryville.

Marian got a break in the opening period when Ron Adcock's punt went one yard to the Maryville 24. Marian moved the ball to the 6 with the aid of a penalty. Mike Schreiber counted from the 1 four plays later. A run for the extra point failed.

Maryville took possession on the Marian 45 on a penalty in the second stanza. Then it completed four of five passes, with halfback Bob Modena's toss to Mike Spencer good for the score. A pass failed for the extra point.

Later in the period, Spencer intercepted a Tim Tierney pass on the Spartan 20 and ran to the 8. Pete Kasier carried over from the 1 on fourth down. Kaiser passed to Joe Tomesek for the extra point.

Two Marian fumbles led to the Terriers' last period scores.

On the first play of the quarter, Steve Bergstrom fumbled a punt on the Marian goal and Spencer fell on it for a touchdown. Modena ran the extra point.

With seven minutes to play, Pat Donnelly recovered a Spartan bobble on the Maryville 25. After a loss, Kaiser threw a 67 yard pass to Modena for a first down at the Spartan 25. Ron Singleton took a pitchout after an offside rap and ran 20 yards for the final touchdown.

Kaiser is listed as the Maryville quarterback in the program, but every backfield man tossed a pass during the afternoon. Several pitchout plays bewildered the Spartans.
